He has released over a dozen CD's as leader or co-leader. The Julien Wilson Trio with Stephen Magnusson and Stephen Grant have been praised as one of the most original groups in Australia and have performed at numerous international jazz festivals.

In 2013 Julien formed his own label, Lionsharecords. The label debut, *This is Always* won an unprecedented trifecta of Australian Jazz 'Bell' Awards (Best Ensemble, Best Traditional Album and Best Composition) and was the best-selling Australian jazz album at Birdland Records in 2014.

Julien has been awarded the 2015 APRA Art Music Award for Excellence in Jazz, the 2008 'Bell' Award for Jazz Artist of the Year, the 2006 Freedman Fellowship for Jazz and the 1994 National Jazz Award.

He holds a Bachelor of Music Performance from the Victorian College of the Arts and a Graduate Degree in Jazz from The New England Conservatory in Boston and is currently a teaching associate at Melbourne and Monash Universities.
